<u>NEW YEAR THOUGHTS:</u> Extract from StF No. 4 7 0 Lord for the Years by Timothy Dudley-Smith

Lord for the years your love has kept and guided, urged and inspired us, cheered us on our way, sought us and saved us, pardoned and provided, Lord of the years, we bring our thanks today.

Lord, for ourselves, in living power remake us, self on the cross and Christ upon the throne; past put behind us, for the future take us, Lord of our lives, to live for Christ alone.

Timothy Dudley-Smith passed away aged 97 in August 2024. Over a long career of Christian devotion, he filled many roles, culminating in his becoming Bishop of

Thetford from 1981-91. He began hymn-writing in 1965 and produced over 400 hymns. (Biography courtesy of Wikipedia)

This hymn, "Lord for the Years", along with "One More Step" by Sidney Carter, embraces the thoughts of a New Year, and as we ended the year 2024, difficult though in many ways it was, we cannot but "give our thanks" for all of God's mercies. We acknowledge how God has indeed "kept us, guided us, and (through fellowship, worship, his Word and through prayer) has urged and inspired us and cheered us on our way" in our spiritual journey.
