**THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK – RESURRECTION BLESSINGS – 1 PETER chap. 1 verses 3 & 8**

***"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! By his great mercy he has given us a new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead...***

***Although you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and rejoice with an indescribable and glorious joy."***

**COMMENT:**

***We have reason to “rejoice with an indescribable and glorious joy” because as the composer says “I know that my redeemer lives!”*** We worship a living Saviour who has experienced more than we can ever do in the gamut of human life. He knows us and understands us. In fact, according to psalm 139, he knew us before we were born – imagine that !

Christ has taken away the barrier of our sin through our repenting and putting our faith in him. He has quite simply, made us right with God. Further he has given us that spiritual peace, removed our guilt and as we read above “given us a new birth into a living hope”.

All of this grace and mercy from God is not to be earned – it is a free gift. For “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son that whoever believes in him should not die, but have everlasting life”. We have just to believe it and accept it. The new birth comes about when we surrender our will to God’s, and live henceforth not for ourselves alone but to please God.

The fact of the resurrection gives us new life, and if it had not happened on that Easter morning when the disciples found the tomb to be empty, our hope would be in vain, Jesus would have been just another prophet, instead of the Saviour of the world ! Every blessing, *John*.
